

Minutes of the Meeting of the Avon Township Board of Canvass

Tuesday, March 10, 2020

1. **Call to Order:** Mike Linn called to order the meeting of the Avon Township Board of Canvass at 8:30 P.M.
2. **Roll Call:** Present – Kelly Martini, Mike Linn, Ken Mergen, LeRoy Gondringer, Stephen Saupe.
3. **Business:** The purpose of this meeting was to certify the results of the March 10, 2020 Avon Township Election. The following information was presented:
 - a. Poll hours – Polls were open from 2:00 until 8:00 PM at the Avon Township Hall.

- c. Clerk (*two-year term: 2020 – 2022*): Stephen Saupe

Certification: Gondringer moved to accept and certify the election process and results of the 2020 Avon Township Election declaring Rich Sanoski the winner of the race for Supervisor for a one-year term, Mike Linn the winner of the race for a three-year term, and Stephen Saupe the winner for the race for Clerk for a two-year term. Mergen second. All in favor. Motion carried.
