Road Name	Observations
135 th Ave.	Large pothole/frost heave at intersection with Norway; area of poor drainage near I-94 – dig out about 500 feet from sign, contact County re wetlands
140th Ave.	Fill multiple holes; culvert pushing up at end of road
145th Ave.	Brushing (3); fill holes; candidate for overlay/rubber
154th Ave.	Brushing & some trees to be removed; branch over road
160th Ave.	McGuinness driveway not in approved location, makes it difficult to see traffic
165th Ave.	Pothole at intersection with Queens
175th Ave.	
180th Ave	Road under consideration for vacation
182nd Ave.	Looks great; if apply rubber this year, fill the few cracks; gravel shoulders work well
185th Ave. (north section)	Fill hole by The Landing; pothole at corner with St. Anna Dr.
185th Ave. (mobile home park)

188th Ave.	Brush tree by pole; some brushing
190 th Ave	Leaning sign; road pitted/cracked

1st St. SE	Road by Sparks? Fill potholes
325th St.	Fill potholes; overlay candidate

360th St. (Preusser)	Rubber down middle; put on watch list; speed bump at end of road back, breaking up on one side
360 th St. (west)	Sign down at intersection with Tower; brush near dead end sign; patch on culvert; fill on curve; check with Myron Felix about blading; hole by culvert near Gondringer's; remove branch at intersection with Cty Rd 9; pothole near Cty Rd 9; signs leaning near FN 17474

Lower Spunk Lane	Brushing on side away from lake; overhanging branch

Narnia Lane	Pothole at entrance; private drive – first portion in good shape, latter portion narrow, needs ditch, etc.

Nordica Road	Brush and overhanging branch near end of road; lay rock around manhole

Minimum maintenance - Schirmer's

Parkwood Circle	Crumbling near 15522 and between last patch and beginning of road; dig out and use fabric
Peach Drive	Gully on side of road; pothole; lots of brushing especially west side; trees hanging over road
Pelican Lake Road	Brush pile to be chipped; wall, white fence, trees in road right-of-way; trim evergreen & elm; ditch & culvert

Plum Hill Road	Excessive vehicles parked on property
Princewood Road	Prune tree by road?
Quaker Road	Fill near Schirmers drive; dip on corner near Bragelman's
Queens Road	Straighten 'Soft Shoulder' sign' brush E of 165 th on corner; fix bridge delineators on both E & W approach

Red Maple Drive	Curbing & fence in right-of-way
Red Oak Circle	Brushing; candidate for overlay
Riley Court	Brush on left side while still small

Shorewood Drive	Sign over culvert probably wrong direction
Springwood Lane	Brushing (1)
Spunk Tree Circle	Fill pothole
St. Anna Drive	Pothole at intersection with 190 th ; may need to replace culvert; candidate for rubber; low area crumbly, will need fabric, 200-300 feet
Sunnyfield Circle	Broken up by corner with Two Rivers; pitted up; should be overlaid
Tower Road	Dump area needs to be cleaned up; overlay in a few years
Two Rivers Road	W of 186 th needs overlay; brushing
Upper Spunk Lake Road	Branch over road; pitting near Cty Rd 156; straighten 30 mph sign; sign down; Children sign; fill potholes; candidate for grind & overlay; brushing near Sunnyfield (1)
General	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All gravel roads should be bladed; 2. Straley property untidy with apparent junk, most items seem related to turbine business 3. Narnia Lane – met with residents to examine road that is being requested for take-over by the Town, may need to talk with Attorney to discuss how easements will work, options for financing, etc. 4. Consider purchase of brusher. Will also need grinder (& workbench)
